HZRPC (Sparks & 5th) Baseball, Softball, and T-Ball - Registration will be held online and begin January 9, 2012. Registration deadline is February 29, 2012. Registration is based on grade and open to all children in grades Kindergarten through 11th. The baseball/softball season runs from April 1, 2012 to June 16, 2012. Cost is \$45 for clinic/t-ball and \$75 for all others. In an attempt to create teams with evenly matched teams, all baseball players will be required to attend a mandatory player evaluation. 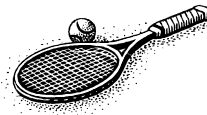
Taekwon-Do

BUILDING USE RULES - Please be reminded of the importance of following all building use rules. These rules are in compliance with the 'Shared Use Agreement' that exists between Baltimore County Department of Recreation and Parks and Baltimore County Schools. Please do your part to be good users of the facilities used by recreation programs. Failure to comply could result in forfeiture of building use. Thank you for your cooperation.

- Parents are responsible for supervising and monitoring the non-participating children that accompany them.
- Building permits only cover those areas of the building where the program is operating. Do not wander or allow children to wander to other parts of the building.
- Please treat the building and others with respect. Place trash in proper receptacles. Do your part to leave the building the way we found it.
- Do not touch, or allow children to touch, any property belonging to the school.
- Fire alarms are for emergency use only. Falsely pulling a fire alarm is illegal and you will be fined and/or suspended from the facility.
- For security purposes, everyone must enter and exit through the designated doors.
- No food or drink, except water, is permitted in the gymnasium.
- ABSOLUTELY no ball playing in the hallways or lobbies.
- Vandalism will not be tolerated.
- No running or unruly behavior in the facility.
- Foul language will not be tolerated in the facility.
- No unapproved selling of concessions.
- No pets allowed indoors.
- At the conclusion of the program, please exit the building promptly so that staff can clean and secure the building.
